SAN DIEGO, Calif., July 12 .-Pursuing their 6,000-mile itinerary around the western rim of the United States, the 23 planes remaining in the National Air Tour will turn northward today in a short flight to Los Angeles, the fourteenth of the 32 scheduled stops. They will remain there until Saturday morning before flying on toward Detroit, where they are due
